Meet Dr. Daniel G. Handysides....

Dr. Daniel G. Handysides, DrPH, MPH, CHES, CHG, Assistant Professor of Health Promotion and Education at Loma Linda University School of Public Health, Board member of the International Commission for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Dependency (ICPA), and Program Director of ICPA Middle East. Dr. Handysides has recently returned from an 18 month stay in Al Ain and Dubai, of the United Arab Emirates, where he spent time teaching at United Arab Emirates University as well as conducting smoking cessation programs. Dr. Handysides also spent time studying and researching the health issues related to addiction, risk perceptions, behavior change, high-risk behaviors and program sustainability.

Dr. Handysides has been involved with Youth Hope prior

to his Dubai departure in 2011 and states that he will “Stand behind YouthHope 100%.” Due to his positive experience with our organization, and his research on the success rates of other programs, Dr. Handysides plans to present Youth-Hope to ICPA in Geneva as a successful model for a working program for sustainably helping at-risk and homeless youth. His involvement with YouthHope has included grant writing and a diligence in spending time with our youth to better understand the population he has a passion to reach.

YouthHope is pleased to announce that Dr. Handysides has recently accepted the position of Director of Health Education of YouthHope Foundation. Dr. Handysides is in the process of developing a program that links Loma

Linda Public Health graduate students with the youth of Youth-Hope. Dr. Handysides plans to provide educational programs to help our youth better understand the risks of addiction and to usher our youth into a practice of healthy living. His hope is to provide tailored classes on topics ranging from nutrition and exercise, to STDs, to drug and alcohol abuse. His vision is to utilize his students to strengthen and enhance Youth Hope’s already successful program.
